
Project Scope

What?

- Intersection redesign
 - Narrowed travel lanes
 - New crosswalk layout

Why?

- Improve safety for all



Existing Conditions


- Stop signs located too far from center of intersection
- Crosswalk at Pine and West Street creates safety hazards for pedestrians



Input from WENA



- Sidewalk Extensions
 - Square intersection design
 - Reduction in length of crosswalks
 - +/- 2,500 square feet of "recaptured" pedestrian/public space



- Bollards/Fencing

Proposed Design

• Square Intersection Design


- West Street and Clark Street are narrowed
- Crosswalks are better aligned and approx. 30-feet in length
- Sidewalk ramps will meet ADA

• Opportunity for Stormwater/Green Infrastructure

- Drainage area/conditions to be assessed
- Funding to be secured

• Opportunity for Community use of Public Space

- The neighborhood could create and maintain a community space (benches, planters, etc)
- Approximately 880 square feet



Schedule

- Finish Preliminary Design
- Hold Public Meeting after the Holiday's
- Revise and finalize design
- Place out to bid this Winter
- Construction to begin in 2019
