Group Lesson Class Tips...

Please arrive for class 15 minutes before the scheduled lesson time. Students should be dressed warmly and bring mittens or gloves and a thick winter hat. To determine your skating level, please refer to the class level prerequisites. If you are still uncertain, register as a Beginner Level student. Our instructors will evaluate each student's skating skills and place them in the appropriate class level.

RENTAL SKATES: Rental skates are included at no addition fee. Students may bring their own skates as well.

PARKING: Troubh Ice Arena is located in the Portland Sports Complex at 225 Park Avenue. Parking is free, and on a first-come, first-served basis. We share our spaces with other facilities, including the Expo and Hadlock Field. Blue cones reserve a limited amount of spaces for our patrons. Additional parking is available behind the arena.

Group Lesson Protocols...

PRE-REGISTER: Students MUST be pre-registered for this class. WALK-ON SKATERS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE ICE AND AFTER THE FIRST CLASS, WE WILL NOT REGISTER NEW STUDENTS.

CANCELLATIONS: If for any reason lessons are canceled, Troubh Ice Arena will send an email and include the day and time of the re-scheduled class.
