DRUG & ALCOHOL POLICY

Preble Street programs do not tolerate drug use or dealing on-site at any time. Staff at the Preble Street Teen Center will talk to individuals who appear to be using or exchanging illegal substances on our property, and will take action when drug related behaviors are observed or suspected.

The following will be enforced at the Preble Street Teen Center:

1. Youth who are suspected of using illegal drugs and/or alcohol at the Preble Street Teen Center (including the courtyard and directly outside the Teen Center) will be out of that site for one month.
2. Youth who are suspected of being involved in the purchase, sale or solicitation of illegal drugs and/or alcohol at the Preble Street Teen Center will be out for three months.
3. Talking about drugs is not permitted at the Preble Street Teen Center and youth who talk about drugs will be warned and then asked to leave for the day.

❖ Youth may get these consequence reduced if they are working on a plan with a case worker.

PREBLE STREET TEEN CENTER MAY INVOLVE LAW ENFORCEMENT TO MAKE SURE THAT ILLEGAL ACTIVITY DOES NOT TAKE PLACE ON ITS PROPERTY.
