Re: Curtis Road Pump Station Replacement Project Neighborhood Meeting

Dear Resident:

The Portland Department of Public Works Water Resources Division would like to invite you to a neighborhood meeting to review the above referenced project. While called the Curtis Road Pump Station, the pump station is actually located where Clapboard Road and Alice Street meet near Sturdivant Drive. The project's goal is to replace the existing pump station equipment with new equipment. A new sewer manhole will also be installed. The replacement project is being completed to meet a regulatory requirement from the Environmental Protection Agency and to ensure that your neighborhood continues to have reliable sanitary sewer service. **Both your water and sewer service will not be impacted during this project.**

The City's consultant, Woodard and Curran, will be managing the contractor, T. Buck, during the duration of the project which is slated to begin at the end of March. The impact to your neighborhood is expected to be limited, though you should expect noise from the work during the day. There will be one evening in the beginning of April where night work will be required. By completing this work at night, when sewer flows are lowest, the contractor can complete the project in a shorter amount of time. There will also be overnight noise from pumps required to run to make sure that sanitary sewer service is not interrupted. These pumps will be electric or have sound attenuation to limit the noise. The project is expected to take 8 weeks.

The meeting is scheduled to be held in the Library at Lyman Moore Middle School located at 171 Auburn Street on **March 20, 2019 at 6:00 PM**. The meeting should last about an hour.
