Re: Powsland / Mitton St Sewer & Water Replacement – PAVING

Dear Resident:

The Department of Public Works would like to update you on the status and activities regarding the above referenced project.

The schedule for this work is highly weather dependent but I wanted to lay out what the plan is because we will have a large “No Parking” posting for the paving.

The week of May 27, 2019, paving on **Powsland Street & Mitton Street** is projected to be on **Thursday and Friday 5/30/19 and 5/31/19**. It will be weather dependent. “No Parking” signs will be posted the entire length of the street for “No Parking” from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM. It is the intent to pave the entire street. You will be towed if your car is on the street. You will also not have easy access to your driveways. After pavement is placed, it needs to be rolled and cooled before cars will be allowed on it as this is a moving target. We cannot tell you exactly at what time your driveway will be impacted but you may be asked to wait for approximately 15 minutes before you are allowed to cross the pavement from your driveway. We ask that you observe and respect the flaggers and any traffic directional changes as we progress.
