If you choose the weekly deduction method, deductions will begin the 1<sup>st</sup> pay period of 2021 (for 52 weeks). All funds are distributed directly from our Payroll Office to each federation. If you wish to have your contribution continue each year to your chosen charity(ies) without having to complete a new pledge form, just check the box on your pledge form authorizing your deduction to continue indefinitely. When you do wish to make a change, you can fill out a new Pledge Form.*

## CITY OF PORTLAND FUNDS



**101. Barron Center Resident Benefit Fund.** Provides for the personal needs of over 200 elders and Adult Day Care clients (dentures, clothing, etc). It is also used to purchase individualized Christmas gifts and group recreational equipment (large screen TV/lawn chairs). (541-6500)

**102. Mitchell A. Kessler Scholarship Fund.** Provides financial support for youth in Portland to participate in recreation activities which enhance their physical, emotional and social well-being. (808-5400)

**103. Portland Firefighters Children's Burn Foundation.** Gives relief to burn victims and their families, prevents burn injuries through education and training and helps facilitate education about burn injuries and burn recovery to the people and fire and medical professionals in the State of Maine. Provides a peer support burn camp for children 10-18 years old. (329-1276)

**105. Social Services Homeless Families Account.** This provides basic consumer items to families at the shelter who cannot otherwise afford necessities such as clothing, toiletries, haircuts, or toys. (482-5205)

**106. Public Health Maternal and Child Health Home Visiting Program Client Fund.** Registered Nurses provide in-home support and education for women who are pregnant or families with a child up to age 5. Provides basic health and safety items not covered by other sources. (874-8475)

**107. Portland HIV and Viral Hepatitis Prevention Services.** Provides HIV and hepatitis C testing, immunization, harm reduction education, and community outreach to the drug using community. (874-8446)
