**BRIGHTON AVENUE – TAFT
AVE TO WESTBROOK CITY LINE
PAVING & SIDEWALK
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

Project Description: This project is part of the Portland Area Comprehensive Transportation System (PACTS) Municipal Partnership Initiative (MPI) program. As part of this program, the State through PACTS pays for a portion of the project (45%). The remaining costs are covered through the Municipality’s Capital Improvement Program.

The goals of the PACTS MPI Program are to improve collector or arterial roadways and bring them up to MainDOT and City standards. Preservation, modernization, and expansion aspects of these roads is a main goal.

To accomplish the goals of the MPI program, the City, along with their design consultants, Ransom Consultants Inc., have finalized plans for a mill and fill along Brighton Avenue, from Taft Avenue to the Westbrook Townline. The project includes upgrades to signals at City Hospital Drive and Taft Avenue, improvements to curb ramps to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and sidewalk and drainage improvements to improve pedestrian activity along this corridor. The street will be milled and over-layed with new pavement. Lastly, the project includes removal of medians and a new striping pattern to allow for bike lanes to be installed throughout the project limits.

The project was bid in late May 2020 and has been awarded to Coastal Road Repair. Construction is expected to start in mid-to-late August 2020 with a majority of the work completed in 2020 and some signal work extending to June 2021.

Project limits: Brighton Avenue from the Westbrook Townline to Taft Avenue. (The interstate will be skipped as it is not under City jurisdiction.)
