Project Description:

This project is a State-led project that is being ran by MaineDOT with the City helping as a liaison and ensuring City standards are met.


The goal of the paving program is to improve collector or arterial roadways and bring them up to MainDOT and City standards. Preservation and extension of the useful life of these roads is a main goal.

The project includes milling and paving, improvements to curb ramps to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and final striping after paving is completed.

The project was bid in late May 2020 and has been awarded to Coastal Road Repair.

The entire project should be completed by October 2020.

Project limits:



Construction has started on Cumberland Avenue with an expected pave date of early August 2020.



Work will begin on Danforth Street starting late July 2020 and extend through September 2020.



India Street will be completed last with a pave date sometime after Labor Day 2020.
